COMSURE PRICING 2025

How to engage Comsure and associated costs follow below: -

1. HOURLY ['ON THE CLOCK' CHARGEABLE RATE]

a. Comsure's standard 'on the clock' chargeable rate (outside any preagreed project or retainer cost) is £310.00 an hour.

2. 40-HOUR RETAINER

- a. Alternatively, your instruction can be managed through a retainer.
- b. Comsure can offer a 40-hour [equivalent to 5 days @ 8 hours a day] retainer, like the project, but at a significant discount, namely £260.00 [£260.00 x 40 =£10,400.00]
- c. In engaging, Comsure asks for 50% of the retainer fee [£5,200.00] on account (engagement retainer) after signing the Comsure agreement and, after 20 hours, the remaining £5,200.00.
- d. After 40 hours, you can roll over the terms at the same rate, revert to one of the above, or close the relationship with Comsure.

3. PROJECT RETAINER

- a. Your instruction can be treated as a project, albeit at a discount of 10% [£279.00 an hour]
- b. A project is deemed to have a support time that is expected to be short-term. For longer engagements, Comsure offer a 40-hour retainer [see below]
- c. In engaging Comsure on these terms, Comsure asks for £4,464.00 on account (project engagement retainer) for a minimum of 16 hours [2 days at 8 hours a day].
- d. After completing a project, it can be rolled over on the same terms or renegotiated to the retainer arrangement (see below).

4. LONG-TERM/DEFINED PROJECT

a. The fourth option is a long-term project based on a defined task(s) and/or a 12-month contract of over 10 hours a month, priced based on the nature of the requested work.
